ESSA Reauthorization Workshop

On December 10, 2015, the President signed the reauthorized Elementary and Secondary Education Act (the Every Student Succeeds Act, or "ESSA"). This bill includes significant changes to rank and serve provisions, supplement not supplant requirements, school improvement and required interventions and accountability. The new law also dramatically reduces federal oversight and the Secretary's ability to "incentivize" policy priorities. The workshop will provide attendees with an overview of the full array of federal legislative changes to Title I and other ESEA programs. District administrators will learn how the conditions and obligations of these federal laws affect their programs.

The session will be conducted by **Leigh Manasevit** who brings a wealth of knowledge on Title I implementation issues. Leigh co-authored a comprehensive manual on No Child Left Behind, and its predecessor, the Improving America's Schools Act, and has written several articles on NCLB. Prior to establishing the Washington DC based law firm, **Brustein & Manasevit PLLC**, he was a federal attorney representing the United States in civil rights cases involving educational institutions across the nation.
